The vivid paintings of Edith Suchodrew combine the modern aesthetics of digital art with the traditional styling of classical oil on canvas. The artist, who has single-handedly curated over 63 international exhibitions of her own work and participated in more than 290 international art exhibitions throughout the world, also works in a various other mediums. Suchodrew studied at the Academy of Arts in Riga, Latvia, and has worked as a professional freelance artist in the fields of graphic design, painting, and computer art. She also has taught painting to high school students as well as working as a painter/restorer at the Museum for Literature and Art in Latvia. Originally from Eupatoria, in the former U.S.S.R, Suchodrew draws much of her creative inspiration from poetry, collaborative processes, and freedom. Living in Aachen since 1991, Suchodrew's exploration into new mediums extends beyond the realm of digital art: she also utilizes silk and porcelain surfaces in her canvas. This prolific artist has been given scores of awards and honors for her work, including the Silver Medal at the 4th International Graphic Art Exhibition at the Art Addiction Gallery in Stockholm, Sweden, Artworks from Edith Suchodrew are in the ownership from Museums and private owners in many countries.
